We have great news on the renovation of our current school classrooms. UPUMC voted to proceed with completely renovating our school classrooms starting May 25. They will have the project completed by August 25 so that we may start school. Every classroom will have new flooring, paint, new cabinetry, and new bathrooms. Two additional bathrooms will be added to 4 classrooms that didn't have adjoining restrooms. Hallway bathrooms will be completely updated. Hallways will be tiled and painted. The

church will also get started on the new wing that will be added north of the church and east of the parking lot. This project will add new infant/toddler rooms, a large gathering space and a new contemporary worship/multipurpose space. That wing is scheduled for completion by July 2011.

please let me know. We could really use your help. All of the contents of the education space will be moved to the basement/gymnasium of our building for storage.
