### Application Process

### Curriculum

The UPUMC Weekday School uses a thematic approach as the basis of its curriculum. The thematic approach supports two key teaching components: 1) information and 2) skill opportunity. The units presented provide for all areas of a child's development: physical, emotional, linguistic, aesthetic, cognitive and religious. The Kindergarten program incorporates a multisensory, structured language approach within the context of thematic learning. Music, physical education, Spanish and chapel are shared with 3's, 4's and K programs. Toddlers and Infants also have a music and movement component.

### Immunizations & Vision and Hearing

UPUMC Weekday School adheres to all State of Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services laws for immunizations and hearing and vision screening. Every child must have a current signed statement of good health and an updated record of immunizations validated by a physician or qualified health care personnel on file in the school office before the first day of school. No child is allowed to attend until such information has been received by the School.

The school hours are 9:00-12:00 on Mondays and 9:00-2:00 on Tuesdays-Fridays.
