The purpose of the program is to encourage our members to:

- Increase sensitivity to all human beings-their needs, interests, and concerns.
- Encourage critical thinking about issues facing humanity today.
- Grow in understanding of Scripture as it relates to Christian faith in contemporary life.
- Strengthen involvement in local and global Christian mission.

About the books- Every year books are chosen to broaden exposure to a variety of concepts. Books are on the reading list for five years.

The books are organized into 5 categories.

- Education for Mission
- Nurturing for Community
- Social Action
- Spiritual Growth
- Leadership Development

Keep a record of the books you read on the reading form that can be downloaded from the UMW Reading Program website or by going to the North Texas Conference UMW website. The Reading Program begins in August and concludes in July when the reading reports are turned in with other reports to the Metro District .
